



IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING COVID 19

In accordance with government advice, The Shakespeare Hospice has taken the decision to postpone all fundraising events up to the end of June until further notice. The Fundraising team have taken precautions to safeguard members of the public by issuing guidance to anyone taking part in any activities being organised in aid of by our supporters, to limit the potential spread of Covid-19.

Please observe the following measures to limit the potential spread of Covid-19 before attending the event or fundraising activity:

- If you have a **persistent new cough and/or a high temperature** please self-isolate for 7 days, telephone NHS 111 if symptoms worsen, please **do not attend the event.**
- If you have **travelled abroad and recently returned**, please **do not attend the event.**
- If you have any **underlying health conditions**, we advise you to consider **not attending this event.**

What we will do:

- Ensure hand washing facilities are available
- Provide hand sanitizers for use on arrival at the event
- Issue leaflets prior to an event or on arrival with NHS guidance.
- Ask event participants to confirm that they have not travelled abroad recently or displayed symptoms of a persistent new cough and/or a high temperature
