



The Shakespeare Hospice Text to Donate Terms and Conditions

Text to donate is a quick and easy way to donate to The Shakespeare Hospice. If you've already texted a donation, thank you so much. You're helping to make such a difference.

How will my donation be spent?

Your donation is crucial to our work, for every £1 donated; we spend 90p on front line services.

Can I donate by text?

To send a text donation you must be 16 years old or over and you must obtain permission from the bill payer before sending a text message.

Where can I send text donations from?

Please note that you can donate from a UK mobile only. You cannot donate using this service from a Channel Islands, Isle of Man or other non-UK mobile. If you donate using this service from a UK mobile outside England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland, you may incur additional network charges.

How can I donate?

You can give a single gift of £3 or £5 or £10 via your mobile phone. Just text...

tshdonate3 to 70500 to donate £3

tshdonate5 to 70500 to donate £5

tshdonate10 to 70500 to donate £10

Occasionally, we will operate a seasonal fundraiser text to donate facility with alternative option such as:

Christmas Jolly Jumper text 70500:

TSH2 Jumper – to donate £2

TSH5 Jumper – to donate £5

TSH10 Jumper – to donate £10

Christmas Hamper Raffle

Text HAMPER to 72020 to donate £5

- Texts will incur the cost of your donation plus a charge at your standard network message rate; please ask bill payer's permission first.

- The Shakespeare Hospice will receive 100% of each donation. We will use the mobile phone number to confirm receipt of your donation by text and ask for a Gift Aid declaration. £10 donors will receive 2 reply messages each taking £5 each. Donations are taken from your mobile phone account or pre-pay balance.
- If you'd rather we didn't contact you again, please text STOP to 70500. Alternatively, you can opt out by contacting our Fundraising Team on 01789 266852 or by emailing us with your mobile phone number to fundraising@theshakespearehospice.org.uk
- Once you have opted out of future text messages, it may take us up to 28 days to remove your number from our database list so please accept our apologies if you receive a text in the meantime.
- There is no limit on the number of times you may make a donation via text but there is a daily limit of £30 on text donations. You will not be able to donate more by text from the same number on the same day, but you may still incur your standard network message charge if you try.

General terms and conditions

- The text to donate message service is being provided by Vir2 Mobile a trading name of RSM2000 Ltd, Suite One, Second Floor, Wrest House, Wrest Park, Silsoe, United Kingdom, MK45 4HS.
- The charge will show on your bill as the number texted and words "Premium SMS" or "Charity Donation".

- The text donate campaigns are live until the closing date shown in our text message to you. If you text after the closing date or if message or text number back to us is incorrect, you will not make a donation to The Shakespeare Hospice but you may still be charged a message at your standard network rate.
- Please ensure you spell the keyword carefully and send your text message to the correct short code or your gift will not be received.
- If your keyword and short code are valid, you will be charged the donation amount when you receive the bounce-back message – this cost will be applied directly to your mobile phone bill. It may take some time for you to receive a bounce-back message. Please wait until you receive it. Any repeat texts will result in repeat donations.
- If your keyword or short code are invalid, you may not receive a bounce-back but may still be charged your standard network message charge. You will not be charged the donation as you will not be donating to The Shakespeare Hospice.
- All supporters must obtain permission from the bill payer before sending a text message. If you are under 16 years old, you must have your parent or guardian's permission to send a text donation to us.
- If you would like to contribute additional gifts to The Shakespeare Hospice, you can donate online.
- All donations to The Shakespeare Hospice, including the donation from the text, are **non-refundable**.
- The Shakespeare Hospice does not accept any responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure, malfunction, congestion, capacity issues or any other problem with any telephone, telephone network or line, system, server, provider or otherwise which may result in any text being lost, delayed or not properly received and recorded.
